### Giving a Reason for the Hope within Us

Some of you will have heard of Apologetics, that branch of Christian thought that is about the very essence of 1 Peter 3:15. Paul reasoned with the Jews and others as he proclaimed the good news of Jesus, persuading and arguing for the faith. Apologetics is an interesting task of which we can either make too much or too little.

There are many aspects of the Christian faith, of the gospel and doctrine that are far from self-evident to many and over the centuries the need for apologetics grew. There are those who have come to faith and part of that process has been interaction with those who have sought to persuade and show them the reasonableness of the faith. God has used those arguments to draw people to himself.

On the other hand the same scriptures remind us that people can only come to faith by the converting power of the Holy Spirit. Jesus reminds us in John 3 that conversion is first and foremost a work of God rather than of the mind or of reason. It's why we pray for mission and outreach as the church always has, to pray God will draw people to Christ as they hear the gospel, as God opened the heart of Lydia long ago.

Nonetheless God works as he will and so be ready and learn to give a reason for the hope with you, salvation in the name of Jesus Christ.
