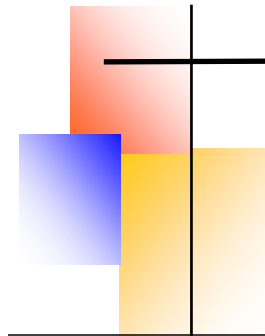

PASS IT ON: THE TRUTH MATTERS

Our culture, quite rightly, prizes education whether the school system, universities and beyond. Upon deeper examination our education system is grounded in the Christian worldview. We see it long ago when God gave Solomon the gift of wisdom. We think of the famous incident with the two women but forget that Solomon spent time studying the plants and animals, the natural world as well as the spiritual (1 Kings 3:33-34). Wisdom reminds us of the import of common sense and of our rationality as a gift of God by which we understand the world and ourselves.

In the middle ages monasteries became centres for learning and study and out of them arose the precursor to the modern university. The early Sunday Schools led to a recognition that children ought to be provided with education rather than be seen as no more than cheap labour. We understood that if Christ was the co-creator with his Father and the Spirit, truth works at so many levels whether personal, spiritual, scientific or moral. God is the author of all truth and acts truthfully in every way. Lies, deceptions and half-truths are the purview of evil, not the Lord.

What does this mean for us? It means that we can speak of a Christian world-view, a way of understanding the world in which we live whether physical or spiritual and by which we live. That world view is grounded in the Spirit inspired scriptures and supplemented by reason, tradition and experience. In a world where spiritual knowledge is seen as subjective and personal, where all truth claims are relative and supposedly tainted by bias or self-interest and inherently unreliable, we need to teach and model our young ones another way. The next generation need to be taught in word and deed, through relationship and community the truth in all its forms, critically, humbly and faithfully. Only then will they be ready to stand for God in this troublesome world.
