GOD CHOOSES, WE CHOOSE

Many years ago the pop group Wham would perform in concert wearing t-shirts with the logo 'Choose Life'. Choices matter in so many ways and one of the things the scriptures affirm is human will and decision, especially our spiritual ones. The gospels begin with the call to repent, to lay aside the things of the world and to turn to and choose God and his Kingdom. Whether individuals or groups the cry went out for people to place the sovereign God of all at the centre of their lives. Many do not but here in Matt 11:20-30 we read of God's choice in choosing us.

When we struggle with our doubts, regrets, fears and frustrations the New Testament teaches us that our choice for God is ultimately grounded in God's first choosing us. He chose Jesus to come as his faithful servant who will bring life, restoration and reconciliation and in Christ he chooses us to be Jesus' disciples. The doctrine of predestination that Paul wrote of seeks to preserve the integrity of God's choice and our choice. Both are real, valid and powerful but it all starts with the sovereign Lord. That's why we continue to heed the call to repentance and faith as we choose the God who chose us in Jesus.

Church Matters

KAC has a long association with Frank Smith of Supporting Hearts in Thailand. Back in the '90s a parishioner, Sandi Papineau, went as a missionary to Chiang Rai to work alongside Frank in caring for aid sufferers, taking the love of Christ to them and their families. At the time many displaced children were arriving across the river from Myanmar. The Thai government considered these very vulnerable children as of no consequence.

Supporting Hearts provided a Safe House for the children with food and love for the body and soul. Against the odds they found places in school for many.

In Mid-May the call went out that funding was very low and that Supporting Hearts was on the brink of closure. This week we received the news that 110 children of various ages have been registered in school for the new school year. Praise the Lord for His provision and answers to prayer.
