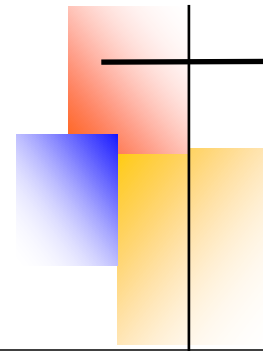

THE PRESENCE AND POWER OF GOD

Much is made today of power, power to live, power to achieve, power to become healthy, wealthy and wise. We all want power, power to be more and better than we are. Today's readings from Acts remind us of two truths especially as we think about the life and mission of the church. Both speak of the presence and power of God in the risen Christ and the gift of the Holy Spirit.

The power God gives us through his Son, by his Spirit is the true power to live, to love, to serve and to strive against the power of sin and darkness. It's the power to resist temptation, to act in faith for the love of God and others, power that does not look for attention or reward but seeks to honour the God who came to us in his Son and who walks with us in his Spirit.

The power many want is a quasi-spiritual power that is illusionary. We think we can save ourselves or we can climb stairway to heaven on our own terms. God comes to save as only he can, and that salvation is both the moment when Jesus died and rose from the dead and we first believed and the salvation he is working in our lives as we trust, love and serve. Otherwise we either fall into the trap of moralism and legalism as if we can act in our own strength and become hypocrites or exhausted or we unwittingly chase after worldly things like wealth, pleasure and influence cloaked in religious guise.

Christian discipleship is far from easy, the call to holiness as we fellowship with God is unachievable without God's presence and help. We strive knowing we will meet and answer to Jesus upon his return, but we do not strive alone. We look to our great High Priest and we walk in the Spirit day by day in the light of his Word.

COVID REQUIREMENTS FROM DIOCESE

- * 2 sqm rule and 75% patron maximum capacity is removed
- * Masks no longer mandatory while indoors at church but if you for any reason prefer to still wear one please do so. That is simply a matter of choice.
- * Hospitals and Residential aged care and disability care facilities -
 - Masks must still be worn
 - two visitors per patient per day (except for compassionate reasons and essential visitors)
 - Visitors still required to show proof of vaccination
- * Practice good hygiene at all times, on entering the building and before taking communion especially
- * Be mindful during the greeting of the peace of other's preferences especially if they prefer not to make physical contact with others.
- * The collection at both services will happen by means of placing one's gift in the basket up front.
- * If anyone feels unwell or at risk, stay home and if need be get tested ASAP
- * Keep alert for state government requirements.
