Old Church — New Life

TEMPLES, CHURCHES AND FAITH

Today we see King David's desire to see a House for God built finally completed during the reign of Solomon. It lay at the heart of Israel's spiritual life as the Tabernacle had before it for centuries. It was apparently a building of extraordinary grandeur and majesty until its destruction in the 6th Century BCE by the Babylonians. It was meant to point the Israelites to the Heavenly Temple, the very heart of God in Heart in the centre of all creation, the place where faith and devotion were to be called for and nurtured. Sadly though over time the temple became all but God, its presence leading to complacency and presumption rather than faith and love.

Today across the world there are Churches and Cathedrals almost as grand, a number of which are here in Australia. We too face the same fundamental danger where these beautiful places of worship that were meant to nurture faith and love replace them. We get caught up in its history or our own personal memories, the craftsmanship or ceremonies past and present.

God gives us many means of grace to nurture faith that point us to God's presence with us, not in a building like the temple, but in the presence of Christ by his Word and Spirit. Stephen understood this in his controversial and powerful sermon in Acts 7 as did the writer of the Hebrews as he contemplated the priesthood of the Lord Jesus. Our hope lies not in material things including such buildings but in the God who revealed himself in Christ and speaks to us through the word and Spirit. When these things lie at the heart of any church or cathedral, it is a holy place indeed.

COVID-19 UPDATE

1. We can now have up to 100 people attend provided we keep 1.5 metres apart from each other aside from couples and families. The chairs will be spaced accordingly. Communion will still be of one kind and good hygiene should be maintained before, during, between and after services. We will refrain from physical contact for the sharing of the Peace for the time being.
2. Again, if you are not well and suffering from any kind of respiratory illness or are at risk, consider staying home. Services will be streamed for a little longer.
