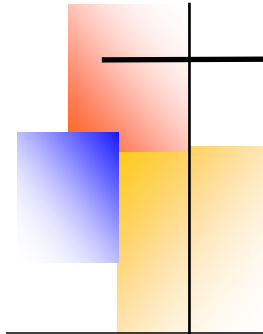

Gracious Gifts for Love

As we think about the gifts of the Spirit in the life of the church one of the things that is not entirely clear is when and where they were used. All too often it is assumed that they were either exercised during the Sunday service or in mission. I wonder though of the gifts, depending on the need, are relevant when we meet in twos or threes for prayer or in life groups. We make healing a gift to be exercised during dramatic healing services or during praise when we can pray for healing for one another at any time. It might be good and appropriate at times to organize special occasions when certain gifts and ministries are the focus to prevent abuse and provide opportunity. Nonetheless the promise is that the Spirit is with us every moment of every day and so the gifts as there whenever they are needed.

Today's passage though reminds us again of the key motivation in their use, in loving service. Any gift or ministry is not there for self-promotion, elitism, empire building or factionalism. Such motivations fatally compromises a ministry and place us in a dangerous spiritual place. We might enjoy 'success' in the moment or for a time but in the end, it's to God we answer. Jesus' words in Matthew 25 and the words of the Angel in Revelation 2 are very pertinent. Do we, how will we serve in the love of Christ?
