Today we look at chapters 3 and 6 of Daniel. They both speak of the same fundamental challenge that is standing up for God even against the ruling authorities under pain of death. Daniel and his three friends are not the only ones in the scriptures and in history who have faced such challenges. Nor have Jews and Christians been the only victims of religious persecution. Nonetheless the scriptures remind us of the fundamental battle between the light and the dark that found its focus in Jesus and those who stand with the Lord of life.

Like Daniel there are those who have experienced miraculous deliverance or who were given the right words at the right time to sway even kings. There are also those who have and continue to suffer and die for their faith in the Lord. This last century numerically was the worst in history across much of the globe. They are the ones who have truly taken up their cross and followed him. How is the Lord calling us to do likewise here and now in Karrinyup, in Australia?
