## COURAGE TO SPEAK

Today's passage from Matthew's gospel is difficult, not in what it means but in the challenge it represents in being a disciple of Christ. Throughout the history of the church and across the world many have welcomed the gospel and others have rejected it. That rejection shows itself in a number of ways and Christians have responded in a number of ways. The one response Jesus and the Apostles rejected was to fight violence and hostility in kind. Rather Christians have sought to do nothing more and nothing less than to pray and to persuade people to consider the gospel of Jesus Christ.

We can do that through apologetics, giving credible intellectual reasons why we can believe in God and the gospel. We can seek to demonstrate the power of the Christian faith through good works and deeds. We can take every opportunity to simply speak about Jesus, who he is and what he has done, what will happen if we accept or reject him, calling people to repentance and faith. All of these have been and are used by God to bring people to faith. What will not work is saying and doing nothing. We have a hope that is worth talking about and ought to change our lives. Through all of this, God's Spirit will work to change lives and grow his Kingdom.

## Church Matters

As I mentioned in my AGM report, the Diocese requires parishioners who hold positions of responsibility within each parish to hold the required certification: Police Clearances, Working with Children Checks or Churchsafe Certificates.

If you are on the following list you are required to hold a Churchsafe Certificate: Parish Council, Synod reps, Prayer Group and Life Group leaders, Youth and Children's ministry workers, Music leaders and Welcomers. To obtain a Churchsafe Certificate one needs to complete a four and a half hour course. There are several proposed training courses planned for this year: Bull Creek on July 14, Shenton Park Aug 4, Kallaroo Sept 1, Palmyra Oct 21 and Bassendean Nov 3. You can book on line through the Diocesan Office for the course that best suits you.

When you have completed the course you will be given a certificate, a copy of which needs to be kept on file in the church office.
