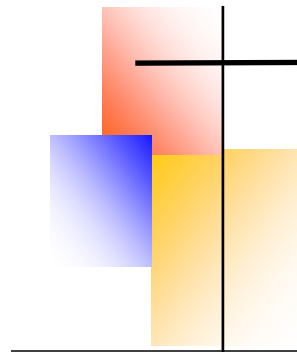

JOSIAH'S ENDURING LEGACY

The story of Josiah in 2 Kings 22-23 is both inspiring and sobering. Here is a king whose love for God is evident seen so clearly in his actions! At the same time even as he seeks to restore Judah's relationship with God and experience a time of peace Babylon will eventually come and invade and take Judah into exile. It will surely come to an end. How would we respond to such news as this? I suspect all of us including myself would all but give up.

Josiah though does not stop and carries through with his reforms so thoroughly and completely, the highlight being a powerful and long overdue Passover. Despite the news his faith so powerfully shows itself in love and obedience at every level. His actions, his faith are inspired and directed by God's Word written and spoken, and he does not hold back.

Josiah's actions in his day speak to us of the role of sanctification in the Christian life. We have been called into a covenant relationship with God in Jesus Christ. We too walk by faith, such faith that shows itself in thankfulness, love and obedience. In the Spirit we too are a work in progress and we too face challenging circumstances where cynicism, pessimism and apathy knock loudly at our door. That's why the apostles call us to hold onto the gospel and God's word and cultivate thankfulness and life in the Spirit, to resist the temptation to give in to the darkness around us.

When Josiah died much of what he did was undone but his legacy endures even today. We still read of his example as a model of faith and courage. We also know that they returned to the land after exile and rebuilt so much. We also know Josiah's descendant Jesus came to establish a kingdom that is eternal and will endure. Like Josiah we too, no matter our present circumstances, trust and work, looking to the future in Christ as he brings God's eternal Kingdom.
