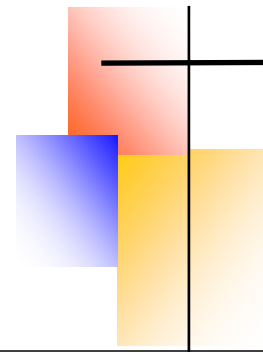

Old Church — New Life

11th April 2021

The Faithful, Life-giving Word, Written and Incarnate

Today we have the first in a three-part series looking at aspects of scripture, mission and worship. Over the millennia Christians and our Jewish forbears takes scripture, the words both spoken then recorded and written to be inspired. We're not talking about the kind of inspiration as we would an inspired poem or speech. Rather we mean by his Holy Spirit that the prophets, Jesus and the apostles spoke God's very words in the context of story, law, history, wisdom and so forth. Through human agents God reveals himself to us by means of the text of scripture.

At the heart of scripture for Christians this testimony consists of promise and fulfilment focussed on Christ. He fulfils the Old Testament and exists as the centre of the New, God's great and final word to humanity in its brokenness and rebellion. The warning at the end of the book of Revelation serves as a warning about not fooling around with the message of that book and scripture in general. The early church recognised the canon of scripture, the books that make up our bible that included the words in their original form. We know there have been minor errors and missteps in the transmission of the text over the centuries but through the process of writing down and editing the stories of Israel and the church we trust that God has faithfully and truthfully spoken to his people accommodating their culture, language and context.

Over the last two thousand years many have devoted their lives to translating these scriptures from their original Hebrew and Greek into a multitude of languages so that everyone may know the good news of Jesus Christ and life in his name. This is our heritage we ignore or tamper with at our peril.
