Facing the Future in the Midst of Change

The events and plots we read of at the start of 2 Samuel are complex, and bloody and sadly all too familiar. Throughout history a change in leadership often sees such trouble as people vie for power and control. Thankfully in this country we have not such levels of violence.

We also live in a time of change as a church with a new Archbishop. Where she will take us and how the future of the Diocese will pan out, I do not know. Pray for her to be guided by humble faith and a reliance in the Spirit on the promises of God revealed in his Word, culminating in Jesus Christ. I want to affirm as I return from leave my commitment to standing on the gospel of our Lord Jesus, revealed in scripture and affirmed in the 39 articles, the creeds and in the Book of Common Prayer.

The other challenge we face is the discussion over religious Freedom. The deadline for submissions is this Wednesday. I strongly encourage you to put in a submission, even a short paragraph affirming the fundamental right to religious freedom in a liberal democracy by which we can proclaim Christ.
