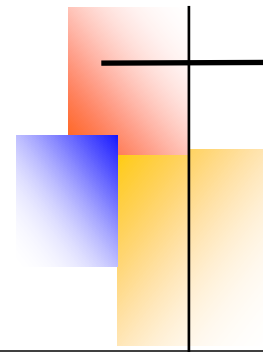

Old Church — New Life

FAITH OVER FEAR

We are a people richly blessed in this land and an unparalleled degree of safety and security. That safety is not absolute but we are much better off than many other countries. Nonetheless, we are still mindful of the reality that life can be and is unsafe at times if not dangerous. The Pandemic is the most recent reminder but war, violence, oppression amongst other things are ever-present realities. None of this is new and God's people, whether Israel in the Old Testament or the Church in the New have had to face these dangers.

When the church was less than a hundred years old it began to face persecution from the Roman Empire whether Nero or Domitian or Decius. Again and again Christians were told to either recant their faith outright or to compromise by offering sacrifices to the emperor as god on earth. Many refused and suffered and died as a result. Were they frightened? Undoubtedly. Nonetheless faith overcame fear, even in the face of death. They understood that death was not the end but that they were truly SAFE in Christ. If the devil could not destroy their faith or relationship with God how could any person. They understood the power of Paul's words in Romans 8. They saw the example of the apostles, church leaders and many fellow believers who died knowing the injustice and evil they faced in this world for following Christ would end.

When Paul wrote to his protégé Timothy, he reminded him the Spirit we had been given was NOT one of fear. It was one of power, of love and self-control and implicitly of courage. They faced lions, sword, fire, to the point of death because they knew deep within that in Christ they were SAFE.

HOW TO BOOK FOR THE THREE SUNDAY SERVICES 8AM 9:30AM & 5PM

- You can register on <https://www.trybooking.com/BJRAQ> It is a simple process.
- Registrations are open from Mondays to Saturdays before each Sunday service and no registrations can be made on the day of the service. We will keep a record of attendance to be safe.
- If you can't register online and you want to attend you can register through the church office 9341 5572 Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday before 12 noon only.

COVID-19 UPDATE

1. Sunday services can still be accessed through our new Facebook page 'Karrinyup Anglican Church Services'. Request an invitation if you are on Facebook and Kevin can give you access. The sermons are still available in audio as well.
2. We can now have up to 100 people attend provided we keep 1.5 metres apart from each other aside from couples and families. The chairs will be spaced accordingly. Communion will still be of one kind and good hygiene should be maintained before, during, between and after services. We will refrain from physical contact for the sharing of the Peace for the time being.
3. Again, if you are not well and suffering from any kind of respiratory illness or are at risk, consider staying home. Services will be streamed for a little longer.
