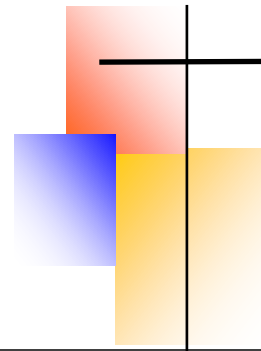

## WE WORSHIP THE HOLY, LOVING, STEADFAST GOD

A few years ago I read 'Losing our Virtue' by David Wells who charts the course of modern evangelicalism in the USA in particular and elsewhere with regard to the present state of western culture. It was a thought-provoking book that ended with an important observation. We have lost or are losing our sense and the impact of God's holiness.

In Leviticus the various laws regarding acceptable food, diseases, relationships and so forth and the cycle of that which was consider common, holy, and profane were meant to teach the people about holiness and knowing and living with the holy God. In the New Testament holiness was revealed through the holy Son of God who came amongst us, making that which was unclean holy through his miracles, teaching and through his atoning death and resurrection. The early church was enlivened by the Holy Spirit and the tragic incident involving Ananias and Sapphira taught them that the way they lived for God truly mattered. Holiness was grounded in our heartfelt worship and godly conduct amongst each other and towards the wider world.

Over time the church sought to express these truths liturgically and symbolically. Within the Anglican Church the high church movement genuinely sought to recapture this sense of holiness in worship through ritual and symbolism. Sadly before too long the rituals endured but the meanings were lost as theology went from orthodox to progressive. Today the challenge as we seek to be a missional church, culturally relevant is how we communicate these realities and not fall into the trap of treating church as little more than a spiritual social club with a few songs.

God is both light and love, holy and loving. Holiness without love falls into piety and legalism, love without holiness into tepid sentimentality and permissiveness. I find myself asking anew, how do we understand, live in and communicate the holiness of God today?

## COVID REQUIREMENTS FROM DIOCESE

- \* 2 sqm rule and 75% patron maximum capacity is removed
- \* Masks no longer mandatory while indoors at church but if you for any reason prefer to still wear one please do so. That is simply a matter of choice.
- \* Hospitals and Residential aged care and disability care facilities -
  - Masks must still be worn
  - two visitors per patient per day (except for compassionate reasons and essential visitors)
  - Visitors still required to show proof of vaccination
- \* Practice good hygiene at all times, on entering the building and before taking communion especially
- \* Be mindful during the greeting of the peace of other's preferences especially if they prefer not to make physical contact with others.
- \* The collection at both services will happen by means of placing one's gift in the basket up front.
- \* If anyone feels unwell or at risk, stay home and if need be get tested ASAP
- \* Keep alert for state government requirements.
