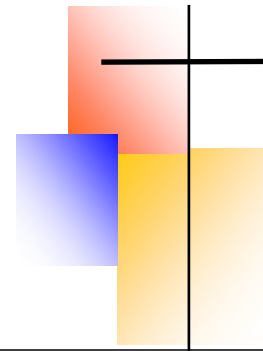

## TRUST THE SHEPHERD

This week has seen the highs of the winter Olympics and the lows of national politics. For over fifty years I have had the privilege of living up in a generous liberal democracy. Such a democracy affirms the will of the majority but the essential freedoms of all minorities. That historically includes freedom of religion. Though it is not as politically enshrined as it is in the USA, it's always been a part of life in Australia. Though I personally was never convinced by the effectiveness of a religious discrimination bill the ability to practice one's faith without hindrance in the public sphere and workplace is increasingly at risk. Most agree that religious discriminations is unacceptable, but this last week has led to an appalling political impasse. Christians quietly served on both sides of politics as community members for years. Now we face the prospect of an election where religious rights will be an election issue. Quite simply I am disgusted by the present state of affairs, but it has been building for some time. My faith is not and should never be a political slogan. No one will win as a result.

Nonetheless as we consider Jesus the Good Shepherd we commit ourselves to hearing the voice of our Lord above all others and being faithful to him. We face those within the church who use their power for themselves as many religious leaders did in Jesus' day and the world who would hate us for sincerely following Christ. I don't know what the future will bring. Matters may get better or worse. Right now an election looms and we need to find a constructive way forward, but the history of the church is one where the Good Shepherd stands with his people whatever comes. Faith and the life that results cannot be legislated for or against. Our hope lies not in governments or legalities but ultimately in Christ who will one day return to make all things new who brings true freedom.
