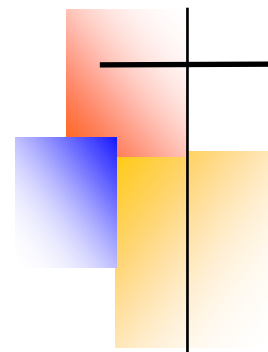

At the end of 1 John the letter closes with a somewhat enigmatic encouragement and command: 'Keep yourselves from Idols'. John is at pains through the letter to remind his readers that Jesus is the Son of God and is the True God through whom we have eternal life. John also reminds us that God's character and actions, in Jesus are, the pattern for our life in giving us the gift of eternal life. He is the model of love for us. The manner in which God loves us and calls us to love him is the pattern for our love for him, for one another and for our neighbour. God's righteousness is the pattern for our lives in living good and godly lives for him and towards others. When we put something in God's place it will inevitably impact on our thinking and conduct. It will also inevitably impact on our relationships with others and the way we treat them. What we believe and the way we live as Christians go hand in hand and so we live our lives grounded in love, in holiness and in truthfulness.
