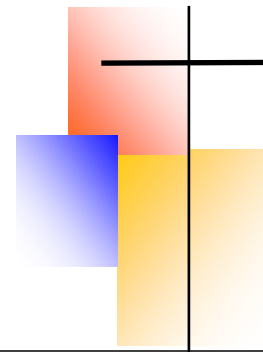

FROM FRACTURE TO FAITH

One of the more significant and unfortunate events in the history of Israel in the Old Testament is the splitting of the kingdom during the reign of Rehoboam. Hundreds of years later Israel to the north and its capital Samaria were invaded and taken by the Assyrians. Assyrian policy was to take the people living in an invaded land and spread them across the empire and replace them with foreigners from other parts of the empire in their homeland, a form of racial and cultural vandalism of sorts.

The history is complex but over time Samaria was seen to be a syncretistic hotbed that orthodox Jews grew to ignore at best or despised at worst. On the other hand many Samaritans believed it was the Jews that separated and turned their back on them. They have their own Pentateuch and version of Joshua while rejecting the rest of the Hebrew bible. They believed Mt Gerizim was the place for authentic worship of God and continued to claim a living connection with Moses and the Patriarchs. So by the time we get to the first century the divisions, rivalries and resentments are substantial and serious.

This entire episode as Jesus speaks with a Samaritan woman is so very provocative from the beginning and even more so when it miraculously ends with this woman running back to her town to tell everyone she has met the Messiah sent by God. In a world full of rivalries and tensions based on race, gender and identity this incident that hints at the beginnings of the formation of the church that saw Jew and Samaritan reunited and gentiles incorporated in Christ becomes powerfully relevant. Such breaking down of divisions is not a matter of political legislation, bureaucratic policy, societal pressure or cultural conformity. This drawing together of people from a variety of backgrounds and identities comes about through saving faith in Jesus Christ, the Messiah who saves us from sin and reconciles us to God.

COVID-19 UPDATE
