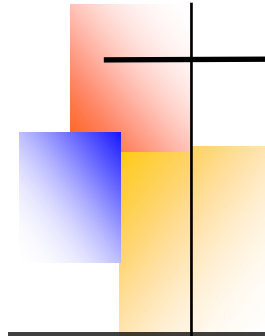

Walking in his Footsteps

Our Lord's death and Resurrection are the cornerstones of the Christian faith as Jesus reconciles the world to God. Any other person can only die for their own sin but Jesus as fully God and fully human dies for the sins of the whole world. Likewise Jesus has an authority as the Son of God no one can have in and of themselves, seen in his teaching, miracles and so forth.

Nonetheless Jesus in his humanity is the model for us as to what it means to be truly human and truly godly. Our redemption and reconciliation includes the restoration as spiritual beings made in the image of God. We see in the way Jesus speaks, acts and relates to people what it means to be fully human. We see in his character and the way he interacts with people a model for the way we are to treat and work with one another. Many people have seen in Christ an exemplar of humanity in one way or another, whether in his compassion, love, grace or commitment.

As we prepare to celebrate Easter, we also see how the Lord models for us courage. The sufferings Jesus went through, the injustice he experienced, and the rage and hate that was directed against him speak of a courage and strength unparalleled. The history of the martyrs bears testimony to the courage our Lord through his Spirit gives to his people in a world that often reviles and despises the gospel. If we are serious about walking in his footsteps then we will need such courage as this as we stand up for him.
