Mirror Reading

Over Lent we will be looking at 1 John that will be exercise in what is called mirror reading. We do it with a lot of reading when we fill in the blanks of a novel with our imagination or provide a tentative answer to a question the text brings to mind. There are many details about 1 to 3 John that are assumed or inferred. Ancient tradition tells us the author was John, whether the apostle or an elder. We know little of the church or churches he wrote to. Any suggestions can only be tentative. The circumstances that led to the writing of the letter are also not clear. When we read Paul's letters most of the issues he addresses can usually be inferred with a reasonable degree of confidence. Not so with 1 John. Next week I will touch on what those issues could have been. Nonetheless in the providence of God we have this book that the church recognized long ago that informs both our faith and how we are to express it as God's people, living in light and love.
