

THE SUFFERING AND THE GLORY

This Tuesday will be the 20th anniversary of my ordination along with Rob Healy by Bishop Tony Nichols. It's easy to get nostalgic about such events but along with the ceremony and celebration that came with the day comes the reminder we made some serious and challenging choices before God for which we will answer. The Transfiguration is an event that reminds us of the challenges and glories of the Christian life as we live in the light of Christ. For a moment three of the disciples see Jesus in his full glory, the glory of heaven that will shine when he returns as the judge of all.

It is an event that informs firstly that the king of God's kingdom came, lived and ministered in the humblest of circumstances. Jesus' status as the Son of God is hidden in his humanity and in his ministry. He picks twelve unlikely disciples and spends time with 'tax-collectors and sinners'. He walks around Israel with little more than his clothes and staff with even those few items taken on the way to his humiliation on the cross.

It is also an event though that reminds us of what is to come for him and for us. It points us to the goal and hope of glory that is the new age he will usher in, holy, pure, incorruptible and enduring. Jesus' disciples, both men and women, see something of this glory in his resurrection and ascension and one day we will see it and it will be ours when he returns.

Nonetheless in the meantime we wrestle with that tension, living in an age marked by corruptibility, brokenness and sin but we do so with hope. Anyone who wants to suggest there is some kind of short cut to glory is to be dismissed but neither do we give up in despair or seek a silver bullet that gets us there more easily. Such was Jesus' temptation and is ours as we seek to live by faith and not by sight until his return.
