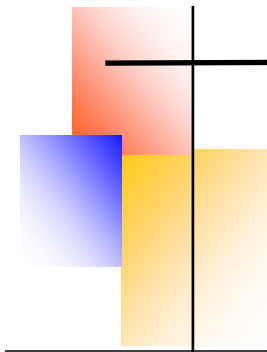

14th June 2020

EVERYTHING IS NEW AGAIN

Today we bring our series on Galatians to a close. It's one of Paul's earlier and relatively shorter letters. It's a letter that gives us an insight into Paul's original calling and his relationship with the leadership of the early church as well as with the Galatians. We read Paul at his acerbic best and his most passionate given the issues plaguing the Galatian Church.

Paul also reminds us in this letter as he does in other letters that being a Christian is not simply about living as forgiven people but as a changed people. Our being a new creation means that and so much more. It means by faith we've been forgiven, redeemed, justified and freed. We've been brought into an enduring relationship with God in Christ mediated not by rules and laws but by the very Spirit of God himself. That's why the effect of the Judaizers has Paul so angry and concerned. It's a very denial of who and what they are in Christ.

The letter of Galatians as a whole is a challenge to the thinking that we can manage our relationship with God on the basis of rules, legislation and procedure rather than faith. It's a reminder that in Christ we have been saved and set free, saved and set free for service in the love and power of the Spirit. It reminds us that we are a wonderful work in progress that will come to completion on the day the Lord returns but also that we have a profound responsibility to live accordingly, to walk by the Spirit in faith and love, mindful of each other day by day. We are not alone because Christ is with us and we are not alone because he gave us the gift of Christian fellowship. This is why we meet, pray and strive, all for the glory of God.

- Registrations are open from Mondays to Saturdays before each Sunday service and no registrations can be made on the day of the service. We will keep a record of attendance to be safe.
- If you can't register online and you want to attend you can register through the church office 9341 5572 Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday before 12 noon only.

COVID-19 UPDATE

1. Sunday services can still be accessed through our new Facebook page 'Karrinyup Anglican Church Services'. Request an invitation if you are on Facebook and Kevin can give you access. The sermons are still available in audio as well.
2. We can now have up to 100 people attend provided we keep 1.5 metres apart from each other aside from couples and families. The chairs will be spaced accordingly. Communion will still be of one kind and good hygiene should be maintained before, during, between and after services. We will refrain from physical contact for the sharing of the Peace for the time being.
