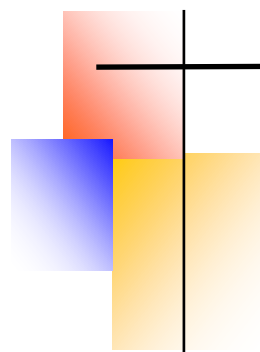

WHEN JUSTICE AND LOVE MEET

In the Australian newspaper there was a recent article titled 'We don't do redemption well, and more's the pity' that caught my eye. The western world, especially with the rise of cancel culture, has become more intolerant, self-righteous and unforgiving. People ask the wrong question, express a controversial opinion or question current so called orthodoxy and find themselves not just censured but harassed, vilified and condemned. Our understanding of the concept of mercy has, in my view, diminished over the decades.

Amos is a book about justice, or more to the point injustice, and God's refusal to tolerate it much longer. For the most part it's a message that is heavy going as he targets Israel's neighbours then Judah then Israel itself. We see the abuses of the rich and powerful exposed, along with religious and political hypocrisy and corruption. Yet at the end Amos opens up a brief window into the possibility of mercy, of restoration and renewal.

As Christians when we speak of justice and a way forward, we begin with the cross where justice and love meet in God's supreme expression of mercy, renewal and eventual restoration. Wherever possible we are to be people marked by mercy. It's important to note mercy is not about timidity or excusing. People will often claim to want mercy or accuse Christians of a lack of mercy when they want us to do no more than turn a blind eye or forget bad behaviour, so they don't suffer the consequences. In contrast the tax-collector of Luke 18, Zacchaeus, the thief on the cross and others knew they were getting what they deserved and pleaded mercy nonetheless. Jesus gave his life, as an innocent man so that the guilty might be forgiven and go free. How will we demonstrate and work towards such mercy for those around us who desperately need it?
