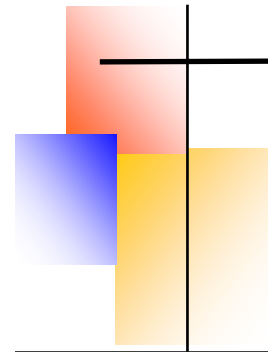

Encouragement in God's Word

In today's passage we read of three people of note: Apollos, Priscilla and Aquila. The relationship that Apollos develops with this couple is noteworthy. They remind us of the importance of spending time reflecting deeply in God's Word together. Part of our weekly gathering is the public reading and preaching of scripture. On this Pentecost Sunday we celebrate the gift of God's Spirit who inspired and illuminates the scriptures. Whenever even two or three gather in Jesus' name he is at work, the teacher sent by Jesus to grow us in Christlikeness and the knowledge of God's will for our lives.

This is why we have bible studies or life groups. It's why another way to teach can be in pairs or triplets. It's why we have Bible and Theological Colleges who offer night courses and the like for working people. They're opportunities to spend time refining our understanding of the gospel, of the Lord Jesus, of God as Trinity revealed in his Word and how he is at work in the world. I encourage you to avail yourself of such opportunities when they arise.
