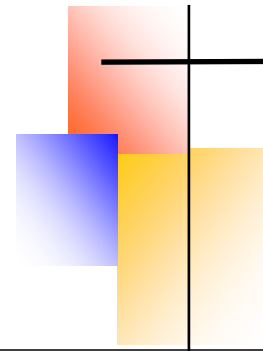

PLEASE KEEP PRAYING!!!

Last week I asked you to pray over this last week as the Australian General Synod met. It's a synod that could have been better, it could have been worse. Motions were moved affirming the biblical view of marriage and the call for Clergy to be faithful in marriage and celibate in singleness. The first was lost, only just, as a slight majority of Bishops voted against it. The second motion was passed, just. A motion by progressives also came up wanting to affirm same-sex marriage as a good thing in the eyes of God and in accord with the scriptures and theology of the church. It was lost.

For the Australian church overall not much has changed. We still need to pray though as we are not out of the woods yet. Later this year we will hold our own synod and what happens there is anyone's guess at this stage. People may take the hint so to speak and exercise restraint for the sake of meaningful unity. They may not! I know concerned conservative clergy like myself, may experience something of a backlash in the Diocese though again we may not. Either way we wrestle with and affirm the truth.

Nonetheless there are things we can be clearly thankful for, matters to be mindful of and much to work towards. As we work through the book of Acts one thing is clear, then and now God is growing his church, somehow, someday. The question is whether we will be an active part of that sacred task and calling as a church and as a Diocese. We must keep our eyes on the Lord, on the calling he gave us and the holy, redeeming love he reveals to and through us. As we saw in the books of Kings God will uphold those who look to him with a due sense of faith and repentance. He will not bless a people or church that is proud, compromised and complacent. We look to him.

COVID REQUIREMENTS FROM DIOCESE

- * 2 sqm rule and 75% patron maximum capacity is removed
- * Masks no longer mandatory while indoors at church but if you for any reason prefer to still wear one please do so. That is simply a matter of choice.
- * Hospitals and Residential aged care and disability care facilities -
 - Masks must still be worn
 - two visitors per patient per day (except for compassionate reasons and essential visitors)
 - Visitors still required to show proof of vaccination
- * Practice good hygiene at all times, on entering the building and before taking communion especially
- * Be mindful during the greeting of the peace of other's preferences especially if they prefer not to make physical contact with others.
- * The collection at both services will happen by means of placing one's gift in the basket up front.
- * If anyone feels unwell or at risk, stay home and if need be get tested ASAP
- * Keep alert for state government requirements.
