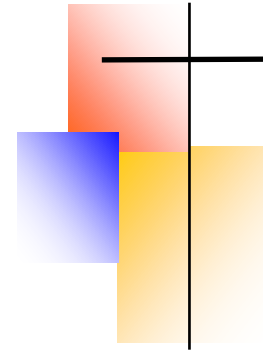

## Thomas Cranmer

Born: 2 July 1489 [Aslockton](#) in [Nottinghamshire](#), England

Died: 21 March 1556 Oxford, Oxfordshire, England

Manner of death: Burnt at the stake by order of Mary, Queen of England.

Spouse: Margaret, daughter of the Lutheran reformer Osiander

Significant Contribution: The first two editions of the Book of Common Prayer.

Thomas Cranmer, born of an aristocratic family, was sent to school in order to become a cleric and eventually studied at Cambridge. When he became an ambassador to Spain he met King Henry VIII.

Having married his dead brother's wife Catherine of Aragon, Henry eventually wanted to end the marriage. Cranmer was one of the clergy who assisted with the proceeding. While serving as ambassador to Charles V, he went to Germany and met key reformers, and was influenced by Martin Luther as he had been by Erasmus. In 1532 he was appointed Archbishop of Canterbury and began to initiate gentle reform. He assisted the King with ongoing divorces and upheld the notion of Royal Supremacy. He then served Edward VI from 1547 to 1553 and began Protestant reform in earnest. When Mary came to the throne, a staunch Catholic, Cranmer was put in prison. He recanted numerous times, a broken man, but at the end at his last speech he denounced his recantations and affirmed his Protestant faith up to his death.
