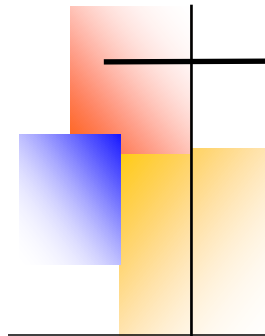

### PASS IT ON: MAKING DISCIPLES A LOST ART?

Growing up in Sunday School one learns all the familiar songs about Jesus and being his disciples such as "Fishers of Men".

I will make you fishers of men,  
Fishers of men, fishers of men.  
I will make you fishers of men,  
If you follow Me.

The trouble is when we grow up the song becomes a trite cliché, an old memory that warms the cockles of the heart and little more. In reality, we're busy, stressed, time-poor and boxed in by one thing or another. Church becomes the thing we do most or some Sunday morning but little more.

The gospels, especially Matthew, remind us that the essence of discipleship, following Jesus, is much more organic and relational. We look out for each other, we encourage each other and we're mindful of one another. We take those chances however fleeting or brief to bring Jesus into the conversation, into the relationship and into our lives beyond Sunday morning. In our fast and, at times, overwhelming modern and hectic age the fresh challenge is how we can express Christian discipleship today.

I think there are two main ways to consider it. Firstly the challenge to take the moment we are given to ring a Christian brother or sister or friend, send them an email or text, do something to make contact and say g'day, that you're thinking of them. Some of us do this and it's a good habit to cultivate. Secondly though being a disciple of Christ in the modern world is a mindset that will be counter-cultural at times as we resist the spirit of the age, especially consumerism and put Christ as that centre rather than ourselves. As we do this, I wonder just what an impact that brand of discipleship will make on the wider world for the glory of God.
