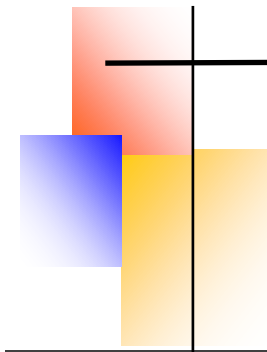

Old Church — New Life

16th August 2020

CHANGE IS IN THE AIR

Today's passage is about the most familiar in John's gospel for so many people, the story of turning water into wine at the wedding of Cana. Its so familiar it has entered into the cultural vernacular a long time ago. Both of the events in chapter two are about transition and transformation, about change that is both expected and unexpected, familiar and unfamiliar. John recognizes, as do the other gospel writers, that Jesus is, on the one hand, the fulfillment of long-awaited hopes, dreams, prophecies and plans borne witness to in our Old Testament. On the other hand, Jesus comes as a Saviour who acts contrary to the expectations of many as the Messiah and Son of God. The New Covenant that is coming takes a shape that is quite unexpected, climaxing in the Son of God, the King who dies a shameful death on a cross like a common criminal.

This chapter reminds us that transformation and change are at the heart of the gospel, dark into light, despair into hope, fear into courage, doubt into faith. The light not only shines in the darkness and is not overcome by it. It also takes the darkness away bringing love, life, hope and peace. As we think about what it means to be witnesses to Christ, this chapter reminds us that in part we bear witness to this hope in the world and in our lives. Today we welcome Rev. Rob Healy from BCA. The Bush Church Aid Society is one such agency encouraging the proclamation of this hope throughout rural Australia, in the lonelier and more isolated parts of our land. We pray they continue to be blessed with the resources to serve this noble and godly task.

- Registrations are open from Mondays to Saturdays before each Sunday service and no registrations can be made on the day of the service. We will keep a record of attendance to be safe.

COVID-19 UPDATE

1. Sunday services can still be accessed through our new Facebook page 'Karrinyup Anglican Church Services'. Request an invitation if you are on Facebook and Kevin can give you access. The sermons are still available in audio as well.
2. We can now have up to 100 people attend provided we keep 1.5 metres apart from each other aside from couples and families. The chairs will be spaced accordingly.
