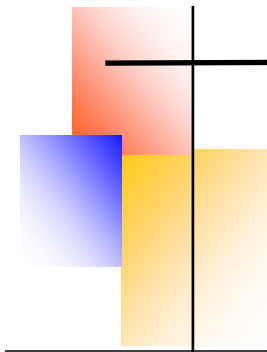

Jesus' Return – What really Matters

One of the criticisms levelled at Christians or amongst Christians is the observation that we believe certain doctrines but practically they make no meaningful difference to our lives. For the next fortnight, we will be looking at Jesus' teaching in Matthew about his future return. We believe Jesus will return to judge the living and the dead yet it's one such doctrine where it makes no apparent difference to most Christians. All too often our belief in the Lord's return is like our belief in the devil's existence. We either give them no attention at all or too much and in an unhelpful way. So what does matter in all of the discussions and how ought it shape our lives?

Firstly, we need to affirm the conviction Jesus is coming back to judge the living and the dead and to restore paradise lost, to bring evil, injustice and suffering to an end. Amongst progressive 'Christians' there is a view the Lord returns when we accept him into our life. Nonsense! As he rose and ascended, he will return to bring heaven to earth and destroy the devil, sin and death itself.

Secondly, all will see his return. It will not be hidden or in secret but clear to all across the world. It's not an event anyone will miss. These are foundational parts of our hope for the future as Christians.

Thirdly, and most importantly as we live in the present, the question for us is: Will we be faithful that is obedient to our Lord, walking in his footsteps and serving him? Paul understands this, teaching us in Philippians and 2 Timothy that his return is our goal, our hope for which we strive by serving and proclaiming Christ faithfully and in love, truthfulness and godliness with the help of the Holy Spirit.
