Carry on regardless...

We hear a lot about Syria today and the deadly intolerance that is tearing that land apart. In fact, Syria was one of the earliest foreign lands where the Christian gospel took root. It was the church in Antioch, Syria, which, in response to the leading of the Holy Spirit, called on Paul and Barnabas to undertake the first Christian missionary journey. Paul and Barnabas readily agreed and, gave themselves without reserve to the task of spreading the message of God's love and acceptance. Many people believed, yet many responded with vilification and hatred. The messengers of love would be driven out of city after city and Paul would be stoned and left for dead. Sadly, the experience of Christians in many parts of the world today is of the same order. There is a strange 21st century relevance in our contemplation of the record from Acts 14 of the experience of Paul and Barnabas. There is also cause for gratitude and praise that, whatever the opposition, they carried on, and the message, in time would go round the world.
