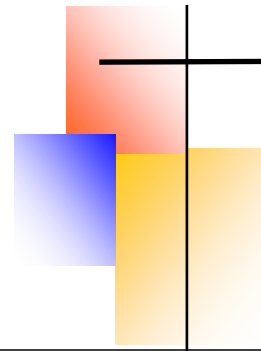

## THE SUFFERING AND THE GLORY

This weekend is another Easter where we remember, celebrate and consider. Ideally as Christians every day is grounded in the life we have in our Lord, grounded in his life, teaching, death, resurrection and ascension. Nonetheless this weekend is an opportunity to consider those events that inspired art, music, plays, movies and TV shows. Take the time this weekend to watch and listen, prayerfully read one of the passion narratives and reflect for yourself on these two days where the gospels confront death in its ugliest and rawest form and present hope of the most unexpected and wondrous form in an empty tomb. We proclaim on

Easter Sunday "He is Risen!". What do these words and all they signify mean for you and for our world?

## COVID REQUIREMENTS FROM DIOCESE

- \* 2 sqm rule and 75% patron maximum capacity will apply to places of worship and other church buildings
