Slowly Returning to Normal

I normally write something about the weekly passage or hot topic of the week but instead to say something about the resumption of services, God willing on the 24th of May. Phase 2 means we are allowed to have 20 people attend a service, not including those directly involved with the conducting and streaming of the service. I have to fill out and send in to the state government a COVID-19 action plan that is quite specific about the guidelines we are obliged to follow to enable services and bible studies and other functions to begin. Any failure to keep the guidelines will have substantial consequences so please be aware coming back to church will not automatically mean all is back to normal. I will be meeting with key people this weekend to map out how we enable services to continue.

At this stage, the Diocese has directed parishes to hold Holy Communion of one kind as was happening just before everything closed. Hygiene will be paramount as will be social distancing so we will hold off on the Greeting of the peace and the like. We will be asking people to inform us ahead of time if you are coming to a service so we can keep a record of those who come so we don't go over 20 and can contact people if someone is suspected of having the virus. At this stage, I am also looking at running a third service in the late afternoon from 5 to 6 so everyone who is able has a chance to come to church.
