THE LORD AND OUR FAMILIES

One of the things about Matthew's portrayal of Jesus in his gospel is that he pulls no punches as Jesus undoubtedly pulled no punches. Much if the language of the gospel is hyperbolic as Jesus uses dramatic language to make his point. The issue in today's passage is that of the kingdom and family.

Our families are a gift of God but some of us our family members, whether spouses or children or parents, don't just not go to church but wonder why we do. So how do we love those members of our family who do not believe, however vigorously without compromising our faith?

Firstly in our relationship, always be respectful and gracious in our attitude, tone and conduct. If family members take offence then let it be the gospel and not our bad behaviour. Secondly, be honest. The older I get the more I realise people generally respect consistent honesty rather than flip-flopping. Thirdly be wise. There may be times where it is better not to speak and to respond to a taunt or criticism or times when we need to speak up. Finally, pray, pray for God to be at work through his Spirit to soften and change hearts. Its what he does best.

Church Matters

As I mentioned in my AGM report, the Diocese requires parishioners who hold positions of responsibility within each parish to hold the required certification: Police Clearances, Working with Children Checks or Churchsafe Certificates.

If you are on the following list you are required to hold a Churchsafe Certificate: Parish Council, Synod reps, Prayer Group and Life Group leaders, Youth and Children's ministry workers, Music leaders and Welcomers. To obtain a Churchsafe Certificate one needs to complete a four and a half hour course. There are several proposed training courses planned for this year: Bull Creek on July 14, Shenton Park Aug 4, Kallaroo Sept 1, Palmyra Oct 21 and Bassendean Nov 3. You can book on line through the Diocesan Office for the course that best suits you.

When you have completed the course you will be given a certificate, a copy of which needs to be kept on file in the church office.
