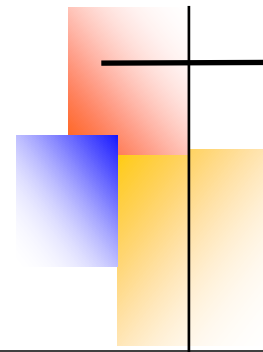

18th April 2021

Come and meet Jesus

We all get excited when we get good news, whether an engagement, a birth or a new job for example. Instinctively we want to tell others and let them share in the excitement as we share in theirs. The gospel is called good news for good reason. In the post Easter season (Eastertide) we have an opportunity to consider again that call to and task of mission. It is clear that it is a task Jesus deliberately gave to the disciples and the church as its Lord. Mission is not an optional extra we get too when we have time or feel like it. It's integral to the life and growth of the church.

Mission is also a fundamental response to the gospel. The gospel, the good news of Jesus Christ is that God sent his Son into a broken world to save it through his death and resurrection and eventual return. It's because of Jesus, the Son of God, the Messiah, the Lord of all that we're reconciled to the living God, Father, Son and Spirit. Our creator is also the recreator who gives eternal life in the face of spiritual death and destruction, who will restore the paradise that we have lost and more. For those of us individually who have believed in Jesus and received the gift of the Holy Spirit we know that now we are loved with a love stronger than death and have been shown extravagant mercy in the midst of guilt and shame, so we rejoice.

Given the wonder of the gospel as the means of our salvation we see people in the gospels want to share their meeting Jesus like Andrew, the Samaritan Woman, the Gerasene demoniac and so on. The gospel transforms hearts and lives and sharing that good news can be as natural as breathing. This is the beginning and the heart of authentic mission.
