

#### iCulture - It's NOT all about me!

In Matthew 16 a seemingly innocuous question asked by Jesus opens an astonishing and significant door into the world of Christian discipleship. It begins with Jesus'; own identity and mission. Peter recognises him as the Messiah, the only Son of God who God the Father promised would come to save Israel and restore creation. The paradox that Peter and the others find so shocking is that this will happen through Jesus' suffering and death. He will be raised by his Heavenly Father but before the glory comes the suffering. This then takes us to the heart of Christian discipleship, a heart that cuts right across our narcissistic culture.

Who is a true disciple of Christ? It is someone who confesses him as Peter did and who so identifies with him that he or she is willing to lay all their personal interests aside for the sake of Jesus, to take all self-interest, all of their personal hopes, dreams and ambitions and lay them at Jesus feet, at the foot of the cross. What do we seek and pursue above all other things? We seek God's kingdom and his righteousness, that righteousness revealed in Christ.

The challenge though is getting then living that, in a culture that has increasingly become overwhelmingly toxic, selfish, narcissistic and self-righteous. The supreme goal in life for most is not so much Abraham Maslow's self-actualisation as self-expression in any and almost all ways. We raise little princes and princesses who fall apart when they realise the world is not all about them and relationships become focussed on how other people, even our partners are there to meet my needs and desires. The gospel challenges us to put others beginning with God before self. Why? Because that's what Jesus did for us to secure our salvation. How does that paradigm, that model challenge you today?
