## Rising to Ever Greater Heights!

Recent events in the Australian political scene remind us of what is to come in King David's reign and the tragic fall that is to come, but at this point his career continues to go from strength to strength. We see him take Jerusalem as Israel's capital, return the Ark to Israel's heart and increase in status and influence. Of course as people enter into leadership and gain power and attract both supporters and detractors. They enjoy opportunity and influence that would otherwise be foreign to them.

So why do some people for the most part only excel in leadership while others follow a darker path? The short answer is we don't know. The seeds were obviously there in younger days, on our character, temperament and experiences but David and Saul remind us of the need for something more, something deeper. David, at his best, found his strength and wisdom in God, in trusting in his character, his word, his covenant and promise. He considered the way God had worked to bless his people and continues to do so. In these things the Psalms show us the heart of those who persevere in faith.
