Pick Your Apocalypse?

Over the last decade or two the doctrine of the Lord's Jesus' return has found little currency both inside and outside the church. Indeed a prominent clergyman in a church newspaper all but dismissed it 20 years ago. A previous generation grew up with cultural references to the Lord's return but now it hardly rates a mention.

Curiously though the theologian Jürgen Moltmann noticed how the language of apocalypse has thrived in the last decade or two. Some of us grew up with the world ending threat of nuclear war. Other apocalyptic dangers include overpopulation, a killer meteor, a global pandemic, worldwide economic collapse, global warming (or an ice age) or some other form of ecological collapse, or for science fiction and horror fans, alien invasion or zombies. Many people live with a sense of quiet terror as my peers did during the cold war that this generation will be the last and the world becomes some cruel, empty wasteland.

Nonetheless the clear teaching of the New Testament is that as the Lord is risen and ascended, sitting at God's right hand, he will return. The apostles were very mindful of this truth expressed by Jesus himself and witnessed to by angels of God. 1 Peter 4 gives us three ways in which the Lord's return ought to shape us as his people. The question is: Will the Son of Man find faith on the earth?
