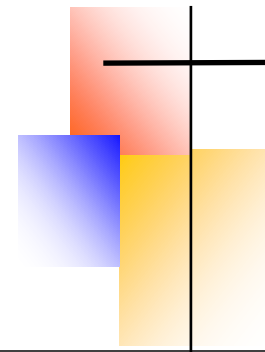

## MADE FOR DEVOTION!

Some have noticed that one of the unusual characteristics of the modern western world is its secularism, the modern apparent attempt to all but completely exclude religion in any form from public discussion, debate and policy. It's considered unusual by some because the rest of the world, especially much of Africa, Asia and South America are very religious. That a political candidate running for office is deeply religious is not a cause for concern elsewhere but a cause for commendation. It seems that human beings are hardwired for devotion, whether to a religion, an ideology or cause, a person or persons or to a thing or things.

We see this in the power of the Sermon on the Mount in Matthew as Jesus speaks of the Kingdom of Heaven (God) and challenged people to consider where their heart is, that is where do their loyalty and true devotion lie? Is it with another God, is it with riches or power or pleasure, is it with family or possessions? The people of Israel were called by God and made his people as a consequence of the Exodus, a people called to be devoted to God. Jesus calls for such devotion to God Father, Son and Holy Spirit, to follow him and trust in him and know eternal life.

Despite the protestations of some it's clear to me by virtue of the scriptures and experience, that we are profoundly spiritual and religious beings. We were made for devotion and if it's not God then who or what will it be? Will it be enough to satisfy us or fulfil us or justify our existence? Will it offer the peace and hope we desperately crave, or will it leave us as despondent as ever? Into this quagmire we offer in word and deed our hope in God as we grow in our devotion to him in Jesus' name.

- Registrations are open from Mondays to Saturdays before each Sunday service and no registrations can be made on the day of the service. We will keep a record of attendance to be safe.
- If you can't register online and you want to attend you can register through the church office 9341 5572 Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday before 12 noon only.

#### COVID-19 UPDATE

1. Sunday services can still be accessed through our new Facebook page 'Karrinyup Anglican Church Services'. Request an invitation if you are on Facebook and Kevin can give you access. The sermons are still available in audio as well.
