Talking about Sex: Christ our Model, Christ our Foundation

Today as we look at 1 Corinthians 5 and continue talking about sex and love and so forth, this chapter reminds us of the reality of sexual sin and brokenness. God gave sex in the context of marriage as a gift but all too often the gift is abused in some way. All too often in the church we respond to this challenge in one of two ways. The first is to 'legislate' with rule after rule, with frowns and fear and rash judgment as if any and all desire is inherently bad and untrustworthy. The other is to find ways to lower the bar with regard to sexual sin, to minimize or excuse it so that we are no different to the world.

Is there another way forward? I think there is in Christ. We firstly must recognise the answer to any sin is the gift of forgiveness and repentance in Jesus Christ. He has made the way through the cross. Secondly we must consider his example, a life marked by love and compassion without compromise. Jesus loved the women around him without taking advantage of them. Thirdly in the midst of our struggles God gives us the gift of his Holy Spirit to resist temptation and the gift of fellowship with friends with whom we grow in Christlikeness.

Church Matters

Once the building was completed the church was left with a mortgage. At the time, late 80s, interest rates were quite high, up to 17 and 18%. We seemed to be just paying off the interest and touching very little of the capital. This was not good enough for our Parish Treasurer, our dear friend Joan Ball. In her wisdom she devised a plan to pay the whole mortgage off in the matter of a few years.

She asked the congregation if they would consider loaning the church a sum of money, interest free, so that the mortgage would be cleared if sufficient funds could be raised. Then instead of paying the money to the bank each month the church would pay back the loans to the parishioners. People dug deep into their savings and loaned the church whatever they could afford, the money was raised, our debt was cleared with the bank and then month by month the loans were paid back. It wasn't long before KAC was debt free.
