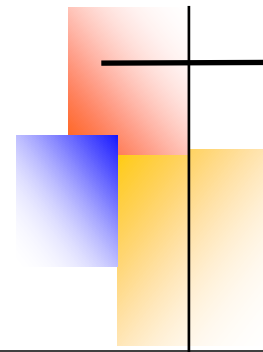

### 'I LOVE IT WHEN A PLAN COMES TOGETHER'

The character of Hannibal Smith in the TV series the A-Team would say at the end of every episode 'I love it when a plan comes together'. Christmas was the first key event in God's great plan coming together as the Son of God became a human being in order to bring us back to God. God's plans were not made at the last minute or thwarted in any way. As God called Jeremiah before he was even born to be his prophet, so he called John the Baptist to be born, the forerunner promised of old and he foreshadowed the coming of Jesus as the Messiah to be born into our broken world.

The doctrine of predestination must begin with our understanding it sought to remind us that God's grace revealed in Jesus Christ is greater than human choice and will. The great mystery we see in the story of Joseph for example reminds us God's plan will progress and be accomplished no matter what. It also begins with God working to bring about Jesus' arrival in the world long before he came, seen in prophecies, shadows and types. In Jesus God's plan was coming together. This doctrine is also meant to comfort us in the choice we have made. If we have chosen Christ, to follow him and serve him, that is a work of God and his providential grace.

It also reminds us as we look at our world, that plan that will be consummated with Christ's return cannot be thwarted by disease, natural forces, governments or human actions. Even over Christmas we see the best in people and we see the worst. We see love and hate, joy and despair, peace and trouble. We can neither claim that good as a means to gain God's favour given the seriousness of our sin, but neither should we dismiss such good but rather give thanks to God from whom all good things come. God's plan is coming together and for that reason we can rejoice in and look to him.
