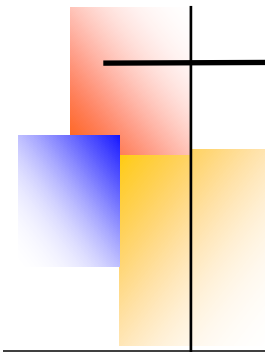

THE MIRROR THAT IS SAMSON

The story of Samson is a dramatic one, of a womanizing thug who still saves Israel. It's a story Handel turned into an opera, Cecil B. DeMille turned into an epic and Veggie Tales turned into an Indiana Jones style story. Like Gideon, many think they know the story pretty well but do we know the point of the story just as well?

I have suggested that, especially from Gideon on, the judges in their flaws and weaknesses reflect the spiritual flaws and weaknesses of Israel, and the story of Samson is the most dramatic in encapsulating the sorry plight of Israel in the time of the Judges. The story begins with a powerful angelic visitation leading the reader to have high hopes in the child that is born to this obscure Danite couple. Before too long we find ourselves disappointed with a brutish thug who chases after anything in a skirt. It's a story marked by riddles and contradiction because Israel has become a riddle and a contradiction. It had a great and high calling and has fallen from such a great height as has Samson.

This is where scripture serves its divine purpose. These are not stories meant to entertain but to teach and instruct. Paul writes "All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man or woman of God may be complete, equipped for every good work." (2 Tim 3:16-17). The church, like Israel and Samson, has been at far less than its best and I suspect we live in such a time. Are we here at Karrinyup as a church and individuals also willing to let the mirror that is Samson speak to us about living faithless and fickle lives ignorant of the great calling we have as saints set apart in the Lord Jesus Christ?

COVID-19 UPDATE

1. Sunday services can still be accessed through our new Facebook page 'Karrinyup Anglican Church Services'. Request an invitation if you are on Facebook and Kevin can give you access. The sermons are still available in audio as well.
2. We can now have up to 100 people attend provided we keep 1.5 metres apart from each other aside from couples and families. The chairs will be spaced accordingly.
