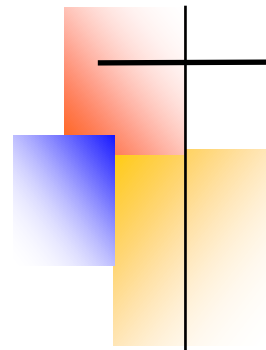

Dealing with Doubt

Many years ago Her Majesty the Queen spoke of the year Princess Diana died as an 'Annus Horribilus'. The year 2004 was such a year for us. We've looked at three challenges to faith and that year fear showed itself in panic attacks, despair in grief and mild depression and towards the end of the year I struggled, really struggled with my doubts.

For many Christians who struggle with doubt of the kind that can cripple faith I think there are two key ones. The first is simply whether God even exists at all or are we alone in the universe and whether the Christian message is credible. The second is whether God truly loves us and has our good in mind. I still believe because the biblical story is still credible and the Christian worldview is the only one that helps me make sense of this world with all of its ups and downs and secondly that as I look back on my life, somehow, somehow God has kept my family and me in Jesus Christ.
