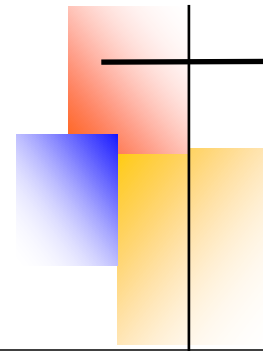

RETURNING TO THE COMMON CUP

(WITH SOME CONDITIONS!)

As of this Sunday we return to using the common cup for Holy Communion. The symbolism behind the common cup represents our participation together by faith in the one Lord. Nonetheless we will not be simply going back to the way things were pre-COVID.

So firstly please make sure when coming up for the Communion you avail yourself of the hand gel and keep practising hygiene. Aside from COVID-19 this year is also proving to be a bad year for colds and flu so it's a healthy habit to keep up.

Secondly do be aware that for the moment the glass cups will be available. Some will continue to have no-alcoholic wine for those who prefer it. If you are unwell and have any kind of mild cold, please consider using the glass cup until you are well rather than partaking of the common cup or if need be avoid having Holy Communion all together that day.

Thirdly please DO NOT INTINCT. This is a request from the Archbishop I wholeheartedly concur with. Intincting has been proven to be the unhealthiest and most risky way to have communion so please do not do it. I know that for some of you it was what you were taught many years ago, but I ask that you do not continue to practice it. Use the cups if need be.

Wearing masks is no longer required, and I leave that to you to decide each week what you will do. I will continue to wear a mask through winter when presiding. As to the greeting of the peace again let conscience and your state of health be your guide. We will stay on the spot, and be mindful of each other's preferences. Use the gel if need to or feel free to refrain from contact for whatever reason. As Paul writes in Galatians 5:13: "For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another."

COVID REQUIREMENTS FROM DIOCESE

- * 2 sqm rule and 75% patron maximum capacity is removed
- * Masks no longer mandatory while indoors at church but if you for any reason prefer to still wear one please do so. That is simply a matter of choice.
- * Hospitals and Residential aged care and disability care facilities -
 - Masks must still be worn
 - two visitors per patient per day (except for compassionate reasons and essential visitors)
 - Visitors still required to show proof of vaccination
- * Practice good hygiene at all times, on entering the building and before taking communion especially
- * Be mindful during the greeting of the peace of other's preferences especially if they prefer not to make physical contact with others.
- * The collection at both services will happen by means of placing one's gift in the basket up front.
- * If anyone feels unwell or at risk, stay home and if need be get tested ASAP
- * Keep alert for state government requirements.
