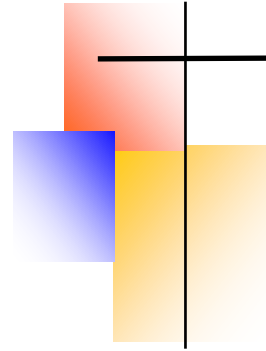

High Expectations

The Sermon on the Mount is one of the most familiar blocks of teaching by our Lord Jesus. Nonetheless over the centuries the purpose of the sermon has been a topic of debate. Is it a new law or ideal to which we aspire? The sermon is certainly a challenge to us all as to the nature and seriousness of Christian discipleship.

First and foremost it speaks of the character and expectations of the Kingdom. The beatitudes remind us of what it means to be a Christian, qualities exemplified in the Lord himself. It speaks to us of Jesus' ultimate significance as the Son of God in whom the kingdom comes. It reminds us of what Jesus expects of his disciples of how we are to express our faith in love and obedience as salt and light in a broken world.

Finally it reminds us of the seriousness of participating in this kingdom. I pray that for all of us, myself included, the Sermon on the Mount will challenge and stir us in the very core of our being. Outward religiosity will NOT do but a life and steadfast faith in Christ will.
