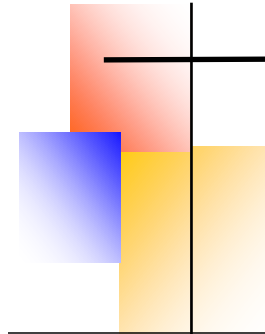

What does the Bible say about generosity?

Generosity is the quality of being kind and unselfish, especially as it pertains to sharing money and other valuables with others.The Bible has a lot to say about generosity as a desirable character trait. God is generous, and He expects us to follow His example.

God's generosity is evidenced all around us. God created this planet that is specially [sic] suited to sustain us and provide for our needs and pleasures.... Above all, God demonstrated His generosity when He offered His Son as a sacrifice to atone for our sin. In the face of such generosity, we can only say, "Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift!" (2 Corinthians 9:15). The gift of Jesus to sinful mankind was the ultimate act of generosity.

As we have been forgiven, we are to forgive (Ephesians 4:32). And as we see God being generous, we are to be generous. Generosity can be manifested in many ways. We can give of our time, our material resources, our hospitality, and our friendship.... Jesus said, "Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you" (Luke 6:38). ...

We should show generosity to everyone, as we have opportunity: "Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you" (Matthew 5:42). Former thieves must leave their past life behind and "work, doing something useful with their own hands, that they may have something to share with those in need" (Ephesians 4:28). The rich should "be generous and willing to share" (1 Timothy 6:18).

God is seeking people who will reflect His character and model His generosity. He delights to bless them and show Himself strong on their behalf. In 2 Corinthians 9:6-15, Paul exhorts the church to be generous in their giving to the Lord's work.
