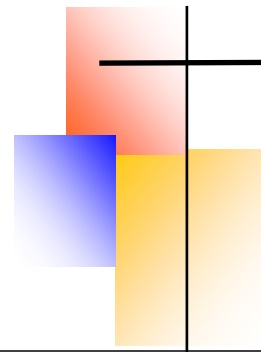

MERCY IN THE FACE OF MESSINESS

We all know life can be messy, really messy. Two areas of life and society where we see this constantly are in families and politics. We all know it gets even messier when both are involved. As you read 1 and 2 Kings it's clear that Israel, after it splits from Judah, is a mess for most of its existence. We read of royal intrigues and assassinations, of power plays within and between families, of greed and war and violence. Long before Dynasty aired on television there was Israel!

We may be entertained for a time by the world's and people's nonsense but the harm it causes outlasts such brief moments. Even in that chaos though we see faith, faithfulness and hope. God is faithful even when we are faithless.

Hundreds of years later we read of the first Christmas that was just as messy in its own way. Jesus is born and placed in a wash trough, the fractured, despotic and self-serving house of Herod tried to have him killed and all of this while Mary and Joseph are far from home. Easter is even messier, the supreme act of injustice as an innocent man dies on a cross, where power plays and self-interest abound and lies, abandonment and betrayal are the order of the day.

Ironically in all of these circumstances we see the wonder of providence as God works through, above and beyond filial, political and social relationships no matter how dysfunctional they are. Post-modernism rightly reminds us everyone has an agenda for good or ill but providence trumps any such agenda. God works in history accomplishing his good plans and purposes that culminate in the coming of Jesus Christ. It may take days, years or centuries but God does work for the good of those who love him, to restore a paradise lost long ago.
