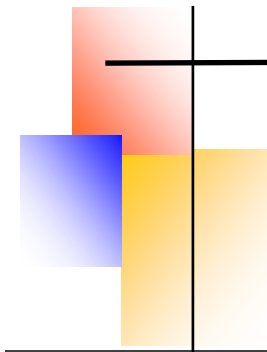

## THE FIRST WITNESS, THE MODEL WITNESS

John is one of the people that feature in all of the gospels and powerfully so. His ministry, like that of Elijah long before, was one of calling people to repentance. He is also the last, great figure of what we might call the old guard. Though he appears in the New Testament he is the last great prophet who stands in that line that began with Moses and continued with Elijah, Isaiah, Jeremiah and so many others. Most of them looked forward to the coming of the Lord on the last day and John is the fore-runner, the one who can say of Jesus as the Son arises 'Here He is!'

In John's gospel John the Baptist is also very important as he is the first human witness in Jesus. Throughout the gospel we will see how Jesus bears witness to his Heavenly Father and vice versa and the Holy Spirit bears witness to both, but John is the first person to bear witness to who Jesus is. He introduces a powerful theme in the gospel that is the theme of witness.

John's gospel and the Lord Jesus are clear. The disciples and we too are witnesses to who Jesus is and what he has done for us. Once again we're reminded in Christ God brings good news to the world, good news worth sharing and living and declaring. Sin, shame, guilt, regret and so forth are unspoken but powerful forces that continue to plague people every other day. Present events remind us we live in the dark and powerful shadow of death. In contrast Jesus came to give eternal life in all its fullness. This is the hope John the Baptist proclaimed with his last breath. How do we bear witness to this hope?
