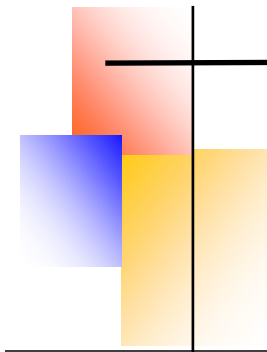

## Communities, Love and Eternity

Today we look at Jesus' answers to three potentially very controversial questions. His answer to the first reminds us that as Christians we continue to live in the world and society we're placed. We earn a living and pay our taxes through which, at its best, the wider community grows and develops enabling us to proclaim and live out the gospel in peace. The second reminds us of the importance of marriage in this world and in this life. Nonetheless, it is not something that will continue into eternity. What does continue on through eternity is love, our love of God and one another.

Nonetheless, Jesus' comments about marriage are unsettling at one level. We live in an overly romantic and sentimental world at times that is in full sway often at funerals. We mourn and celebrate sometimes life and death and, if they lived a life happily married, trust they will be reunited with their spouse in the next life. God gave us the gift of marriage firstly for companionship and secondly for procreation.

Throughout scripture, we see traditional marriage is a reflection, a mirror that reflects the relationship between God and his people whether God and Israel or the Lord Jesus and the Church. They are cherished relationships into which we invest time and effort, love and commitment. They might not endure into eternity, though the memory of them I am sure will, but like life marriage still matters so very much. They are places where we can let self-interest hold sway and bring ruin or let the love of God take hold and bring great blessing. Each and every day for those of us married let's choose the latter.
