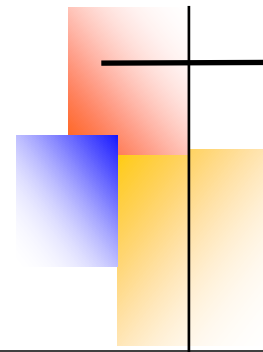

Old Church - New Life

Children, Life and Eternal Life

Year ago I went into a church in the bush and looked at the plaques on the walls. One was in memory of a number of people who were all young children who did not live beyond the age of 6, dying before the discovery of penicillin. All of the gospels include stories of Jesus healing, delivering or even resurrecting children. More often we know nothing of their background and how these things came to be. In the ancient world with no penicillin, illnesses we take for granted were potential killers such as the flu or common cold. The stories of Jesus saving children become even more poignant, such as today's from John 4, because there is nothing more heartbreaking than the death of a child whether in the womb, as an infant or youth. A life filled with hopes and dreams comes to nothing and we are devastated. We forget that it was common occurrence in the ancient world as it is in most third world countries.

We know Jesus loved children and spoke of them as pointers to the nature of faith and God's kingdom. The stories of resurrection also speak of the wonder and power of the gift of eternal life, a gift stronger than death and more enduring than anything on earth. It's a gift that ought to enliven hope, and courage as well as faith. Many are grieving in the west on a scale rarely seen except at times of war. Many are fearful on a scale again not seen since wartime. Many are anxious and depressed, lacking hope in the face of powers large and small we cannot control whether viruses or cyclones. Jesus came stood firm in the face of all of these forces and triumphed because he was the Son of God and the life-giving word. We pray for a renewal and revival of such faith here in Australia and beyond because our good God is greater than the hostile world in which we live.
