Once all the individual loans from parishioners had been paid back. The Parish Treasurer (Joan Ball) approached the KAC council with another idea. She wanted to raise a further \$50 000 to repay the money that St Columba's, Scarborough had given KAC that started our building program. This was crowd funding before its time. The Church Council gave its approval and St Columba's was offered a return of their money. They said that the money had been a gift and so the \$50 000 was paid forward to a parish that was commencing its building program. The recipient was the parish of Quinn's Rock and the community of St Hilda. It was a day of celebration when a group from KAC attended the commissioning of the church building with its beautiful panoramic view of the ocean.
