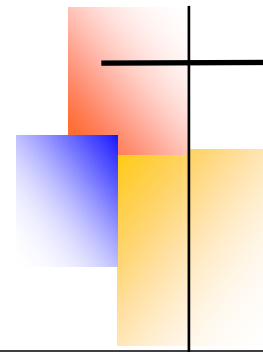

A PROMISE KEPT!

The readings this Sunday take us to promises made long ago that were fulfilled with Jesus' coming. We've all made promises over the years, some of which we've forgotten or even broken and others which we have kept. Some in Israel may have wondered if God had forgotten the promise to David in particular especially when Israel went into exile in the 6th century BC but we see hints in some books that he did not. We then read of saints and servants like Simeon and Anna who new God had not forgotten the promise to David that his dynasty would last forever, that the Messiah would come to bring in God's kingdom. When they saw Jesus, those hopes were fulfilled. Mary and Joseph are both told by Gabriel the baby miraculously conceived would be the fulfilment of age-old promises as the long-awaited Messiah bringing in God's kingdom.

These things matter because they tell us that despite appearances sometimes God is faithful and keeps his promises as does the Lord Jesus. The promises of forgiveness, eternal life, adoption into God's family and God's good purposes for our lives are promises we can hold onto because Jesus' coming into the world is such an astonishing fulfilment of the promise to David.

These things also matter in a pessimistic and cynical age where promises are often broken or forgotten whether deliberately or accidentally. We often doubt, question and ignore those in authority questioning their intent and/or ability. God on the other hand may take his time, but in his sovereign will he is trustworthy and true and our hope in him is not wasted in any way. It's just another reason to rejoice despite a difficult year.
