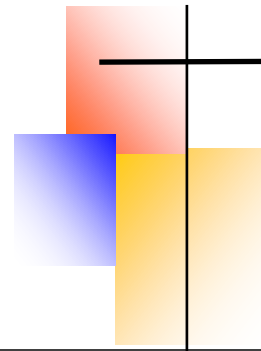

LIVING DAY BY DAY, PRAYING IN HOPE

In the afternoon we've been and are working through the Lord's Prayer. It was immortalised as a pop song by Sister Janet Mead who died last month and is the preeminent prayer taught to us by Jesus. It's a prayer that in essence teaches us to pray to our loving Heavenly Father in two ways, the second following on from the first.

Firstly having acknowledged our great, holy, sovereign and loving Father, we pray he will work his purposes and will here on earth as he does in heaven. Long ago paradise was lost, and we pray he will restore that paradise in the form of the Heavenly Jerusalem. It's important to note we pray God will do this. All too often Christians misread prophecy as if it is our duty or we are able to make it happen. We are God's agents of change in this world but we do so humbly, faithfully and simply by living lives marked by godliness, service and witness. He'll take care of the rest.

Secondly the prayer then moves onto our praying he will sustain, care for and protect us in the present as we live day by day. We pray for what we need, we pray for his mercy and kindness as we extend that mercy to others and we pray he will protect us from the powers of darkness within and without that are around us in this present Dark Age.

We look to God and we act in faith with hope and love. We live in a world where people let one another down, disappoint or hurt. In contrast we pray to the Father who loves us and as revealed and demonstrated that love in his Son Jesus. The evil one tempts us primarily to doubt that love, mistrust God's motives and question his will. The Lord's Prayer is a great antidote to such doubts as we look to him.
